





UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The following information is intended to clarify the Orange County Schools dress code and should be used as a guide. The complete dress code is posted online at www.ocps.net in the Code of Student Conduct

<p><u>Head</u> -All caps, visors, hoods must be removed when entering a building -Bandanas are not to be worn</p>	<p><u>Acceptable Outside Only</u></p> 	<p><u>Not Acceptable</u></p> 
<p><u>Upper Garments</u> -All top-layer garments must follow the 4 finger rule across the shoulders. However, No muscle tanks (even 4 fingers) can be worn. -Bare midriffs and bare sides should not be shown even when arms are extended above the head. - Garments and/or jewelry which display or suggest sexual, vulgar, drug, alcohol, or tobacco-related wording/graphics may not be worn. -No shear (see-through) material can be worn without a tank top underneath. Bandeaux/bras only, under a shear top are not acceptable. A spaghetti strap shirt that covers the bra, stomach, and mid-lower back is acceptable. -A female student can wear tops with cut outs down the arms as long as the bra strap is covered.</p>	<p><u>Acceptable</u></p> 	<p><u>Not Acceptable</u></p> 
<p><u>Lower Garments</u> - Undergarments MUST remain entirely covered even while seated. - Hemlines of shorts, dresses, and skirts must cover the posterior region of the student. - Clothing that is too tight or revealing is unacceptable.</p>	<p><u>Acceptable</u></p> 	<p><u>Not Acceptable</u></p> 
<p>- Leggings can be worn individually as long as they are not sheer. If they are sheer the student must wear a lower garment over them that cover their posterior region. -Sweat pants are acceptable, however, PJs are not.</p>	<p><u>Acceptable</u></p> 	<p><u>Not Acceptable</u></p>
